



Dismantle the Exhibition

Try to leave the exhibition up for as long as you can—students worked hard to create the exhibition and appreciate having the chance to for the community to see it. Try to extend the opportunity for visitation well beyond the opening event.

School museum exhibitions must eventually be dismantled. If you can, move portions of your exhibition to another location so it can continue being used it as a teaching tool.

Some ideas:

- Distribute components of your exhibit to various parts of your school (lobby, main office, grade level or department wing, and so on)
- Display your exhibit at another school in your district.
- Send your exhibit to a local museum or community center for display.
- Use portions of your exhibit in the continuing curriculum.
